BEXAR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 A RESOLUTION FOR THE 2023 TAX RATE RESOLUTIONS # 20230831-001

WHEREAS, the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 2 desires to adopt a tax rate for the year 2023; and

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 2 has adopted a tax rate of 0.083941 for each \$100.00 of taxable value, effectively a 3.95192 percent increase in the tax rate.

FURTHER RESOLVED, THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE; AND

FURTHER RESOLVED, THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 3.95192 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS IMPOSED ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$16.63.

This total tax rate shall be levied as follows:

There shall be levied and collected upon all taxable property in Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 2 for the year 2023, for the use of the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 2, an ad valorem tax for maintenance and operations of \$0.083941 on each \$100.00 of taxable property so assessed to be credited to the General Fund of Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 2.

There shall be levied and collected upon all taxable property in Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 2 for the year 2023, for the use of the Bexar County Emergency Services District No.2, an ad valorem interest and sinking of \$0.00 on each \$100.00 of taxable property so assessed to be credited to the Debt Fund of Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 2.
