MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 3, 2024

Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 2 conducted a meeting in the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 2 Meeting Room located at 14515 Omicron Drive, San Antonio, TX 78245, to discuss the following:

- 1. Call the Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 2 meeting to order and establish a quorum.

 Commissioner Harris called the meeting to order at 7:07 PM (19:07). A quorum was established with Commissioner Harris, Commissioner Cash, and Commissioner Rait present. Commissioner Fite and Commissioner Noakes were absent.
- 2. Citizen's Public Comment (Speakers will be limited to three (3) minutes to address the Board. The Board will not comment or engage in discussion). There were no requests for Citizen's Public Comment.
- 3. Deliberation, update, and action regarding pending and completed projects in Monday application. There was no action taken on Item 3.
- 4. Deliberation, update, and action regarding the August 27, 2024, and September 3, 2024, meeting minutes. Commissioner Rait motioned to approve the meeting minutes from August 27, 2024, and September 3, 2024, as presented. Commissioner Harris made a second to the motion.  - e. T-Shirt Proposal—Commissioner Rait made a motion to approve Big Frog's proposal to purchase uniform t-shirts for \$33,783.50. Commissioner Cash seconded the motion. The motion carried with 4 ave and 0 ney.
