- 6. Deliberation, update, and action regarding the election of Bexar County Emergency Services District No. 2 Commissioners to officer positions on the board.**
- 7. Deliberation, update, and action regarding the Bexar County Emergency Services Districts Association, including but not limited to selection of primary and alternate ESD2 representatives to the Association.**
- 8. Determine the next meeting's date, time, and agenda items.**
- 9. Adjourn.**
